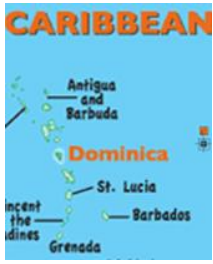


Exciting news for our very own Aaron Shumway!
